Your affiant has been assigned to investigate the Aggravated Assault against Metro Police Officer Joshua Lippert. On 02/10/2017 at approximately 1245 hours Officer Lippert observed a vehicle (GMC, Yukon) drive past a stop sign without stopping at Summer Place and South 6th Street. Officer Lippert activated his blue lights to stop the driver of the vehicle. The driver of the vehicle and Officer Lippert both exited their vehicles. The driver who was later identified as Jocques Clemmons then rushed towards Officer Lippert. Officer Lippert got into Mr. Clemmons pathway to prevent his escape. Mr. Clemmons then changed directions and ran to his left attempting to flee from Officer Lippert. Officer Lippert chased Mr. Clemmons and upon catching up with Mr. Clemmons, a physical confrontation occurred. During the physical confrontation a handgun was either dropped by Mr. Clemmons or fell from the person of Mr. Clemmons. Mr. Clemmons was able to recover and maintain control of his handgun from the location on the parking lot where the handgun fell. At this point, Mr. Clemmons held his handgun in his right hand and Officer Lippert felt threatened by Mr. Clemmons who was armed with the handgun.
